



Shout, shout it all out

Purpose:

Find answers and/or solutions to a question or an issue you want to work on.

Timeframe: no restrictions

Group-size: up to 30

Age group: all age groups

Materials:

- Paper
- Pens
- Something to stand on, e.g. a chair
- Megaphone

Instruction:

1. Travel to a place where you are likely to find peers. This could be the park, a shopping mall, public station, ... Look for a place that's linked to one of the issues you want to tackle. For example: if you want to tackle plastic garbage in public places, travel to a place where there's no bin around but lots of pollution.
2. Write down one or more questions on a piece of paper and shout it out loud. Ask people to reply by shouting their answers through the megaphone.
3. Document the answers so you have something to use as a reference.
